Eligibility: Newport News, Hampton, and Yorktown residents, 19 years or older with no medical insurance and household income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty. Proof of income & residency, Photo ID, social security card required.

Fees: \$15 administrative fee at the time of eligibility screening, \$25 annual fee, and \$10 per dental visit.

Services: Dental Services 3-4 days/week, including denture program. Oral exams, amalgams (restorations), root canals, x-rays, restorations, sealants, extractions, crowns, dentures.

Eligibility: All Medical Clinic patients are eligible (as long as documentation is up to date), those with incomes up to 300% FPG, Medicaid and low-income Medicare patients with proper documentation, and those living outside of the clinic's primary service area.

Eligibility Screening Hours (at main clinic facility): Monday: 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM; Tuesdays: 4:00 PM – 6:00 PM; Wednesdays: 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM; Thursdays 4:00 PM - 6:00 PM; Fridays: 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM

Fees: Adults pay \$25 in advance of appointment. Children are free.
