With direction from the Executive Director, The Director of Social Work Programs will direct the implementation of social work program activities, case management, and interventions for the Journey Home Project. The individual must have experience working with youth and families, specifically related to substance use disorders. Additional experience working with the homeless and/or precariously housed is highly beneficial. Master's Degree in Social Work or Counseling from an accredited graduate program preferred. #### **Primary Responsibilities:**

- Oversee the Journey Home Project scope of work, and will work in collaboration with the BSYFS Clinical Director to provide supervision of staff and volunteers.
- Design and implement a strengths-based case management system.
- Organize and train staff on CLAS standards and cultural competencies related to youth and their families who are either homeless or precariously housed.
- Train staff on SAMHSA's SOAR curriculum and participate in the SOAR steering committee on a regional level.
- Train and conduct case management assessments with youth and their families.
- Provide problem-solving solutions for youth and their families to stabilize and move them out of homelessness.
- Conducts group sessions. Prepares lesson plans and training materials for educational programming.
- Consults with representatives of other agencies or programs and provides and coordinates client case management services.
- Makes professional and educational presentations to agency, staff and the public.
- Performs related duties and responsibilities as required.

#### **Qualifications/Skills & Knowledge Requirements**

**Education:** Master's Degree in Social Work or Counseling in either a CSWE or CACREP accredited graduate program preferred, Bachelor's Degree in a human services area with experience is desired.

#### **Environment/Physical Demands**

No special physical demands are required to perform the work. The successful candidate will be required to work extended hours at times to complete projects or attend meetings outside of normal operating hours.
