****Assistant Camp Director, age 21+, \$375 - \$475 per week**

Assist Camp Director in the daily operations of camp including helping coordinate pre-camp training. Supervise health and unit staff. Assume the responsibilities of Camp Director as needed. Prior camp and supervisory experience required. Must be an approved camp driver.

***Program Coordinator, age 18+ (21 preferred), \$275-\$375 per week**

Based on the weekly theme, plan, set-up and facilitate fun and engaging all camp activities and theme dinners. Supervise and coordinate scheduling for arts, adventure, and aquatics staff. Transport campers to offsite program locations as needed. Prior camp and supervisory experience required. Must be an approved camp driver.

***Health & Unit Coordinator, age 18+ (21 preferred), \$275 - \$375 per week**

Oversee wellness and safety of campers and staff. Manage health center operations and medical records. Dispense medication to campers. Provide first aid injury treatment. License as RN, LPN, EMT or Wilderness First Aid certification required. Supervise and coordinate scheduling for all unit staff. Prior camp and supervisory experience required. Must be an approved camp driver.

***Food Service Coordinator, age 18+ (21 preferred), \$275 - \$375 per week**

Oversee management of food service operations including the planning, preparing and cooking of meals. Supervise kitchen staff and insure compliance with health code standards. Experience in quantity cooking, kitchen management and supervisory experience required. Food Handler certification required. Food Manager certification preferred.

***CIT Coordinator, age 18+ (21 preferred), \$275 - \$375 per week**

Oversee and implement the three part GSCCC leadership program: outdoor leaders, CIT I and CIT II. Responsible for training CITs to become staff, guiding and leading the staff in the care of the campers, and facilitating activities. Must to be an approved camp driver.

****Aquatics Lead, age 18+ (21 preferred), \$250 - \$350 per week**

Develop and implement all pool and waterfront programs. Supervise waterfront facilities/equipment, staff, and operations. Lifeguard certification required. Boating certification preferred (training provided).

***/**Unit Lead, age 18+ (21 preferred), \$250 - \$325 per week**

Manage the operations of a camp unit and oversee the health, well-being, and safety of campers. Plan and coordinate unit program and schedule with campers and unit staff. Supervise unit counselors. Facilitate archery instruction (training provided). Prior camp experience and group leadership skills required.

****Aquatics Counselor age 18+, \$230 - \$280 per week**

Coordinate and deliver pool and waterfront activities. Lifeguard certification required. Boating certification preferred (training provided). Supervise campers in unit when not delivering aquatics program.

***/**Adventure Counselor, age 18+, \$230 - \$280 per week**

Coordinate and deliver adventure activities such as hiking, climbing, ropes (low & high), and archery. Lead activities and maintain equipment. Certification or documented training in low/high ropes required (training provided) and previous experience teaching and managing a ropes course and archery program preferred. Supervise campers in unit when not delivering adventure program.

****Arts Counselor age 18+, \$230 - \$280 per week**

Coordinate and deliver art activities for each unit. Manage arts inventory. Creativity and patience required. Supervise campers in unit when not delivering art program.

***/**Unit Counselor, age 18+, \$220 - \$270 per week**

Assist with managing the daily operations of a camp unit and implement unit programs. Supervise the health and well-being of campers. Experience working with youth and desire to create future leaders required.

***Kitchen Assistant, age 18+, \$200 - \$240 per week**

Assist with food service operations, including food preparation, dining hall operations and dishwashing/cleaning. Food Handlers certification required.
