This position will work closely with a dedicated team of staff and volunteers to ensure that our interpretive experiences can also successfully connect to the indoor museum galleries in alignment with the Foundation's strategic priorities.

- Ability to write and develop, implement and evaluate inquiry based and dialogic education programs.
- Skilled in presenting interpretive/education programs to diverse audiences.
- Ability to plan, prioritize, schedule, and implement multiple projects.
