Museum Educator I — Onsite Education (*Part-Time/wage*)

Our Museum Educator I positions provide **flexible, part-time hours** teaching about 17th and 18th century history in an active, engaging manner that shares diverse perspectives and creates relevance to today. No previous content knowledge necessary.

Initial training in content and methodology prepares educators to present engaging tours of Jamestown Settlement and the American Revolution Museum at Yorktown to students of all ages, work with the public through camps and hands-on history carts, and more. You will take a group through permanent galleries and living history areas, interact with costumed interpreters, and utilize reproduced objects to make history relevant to today.

What are the qualifications for this position?

- Experience working with children in either a professional or volunteer capacity
- Excellent communication skills
- Proven ability to quickly learn and apply new information
- Skills for working effectively with the public, including people of diverse cultures, ages, abilities, and economic backgrounds
- Willingness to work outdoors in all reasonable weather conditions.

High school diploma or equivalent is preferred.
